
# WE HAVE A SIMPLE MOTTO HERE: Oravide a Place for God to Change Lives




## MANAGER'S PERSPECTIVE // FOOD, WORK, AND STRENGTH

## **NEW 2016 TEEN LEADERSHIP** TRAINING PROGRAM: **BE "THE CORE"**

In the past if you wanted to volunteer at a week of you could be a youth sponsor from your church. This isn't changing. If you want to be a youth sponsor, you'll need to contact your church, who is responsible for recruiting, screening, and training these critically important roles in our youth camps

The other way to be involved was to sign up as kitchen help for a single week of camp by contacting the camp dean. This is changing. New for 2016, the camp will be directly accepting applications from teenagers (ages 13-18) who are



interested in a new leadership training program during the summer at camp. We're calling this, "The Core" because we are looking for students who are committed Christian workers and interested in leadership training. We are asking for approximately 2-3 week commitments and will additionally reward participants in this program by paying for their regular week of camp. The five opportunities will be May 30 - June 11,

Students can apply for 1 block or more, and with each subsequent block will be assigned more responsibility. The main areas of work responsibility will be kitchen duty, some grounds work, and cabin cleaning on participate and/or lead in daily devotions, and will certainly include learning to lead/follow as a member of a Christ-like servant leadership team. We will begin accepting applications on March 1st. Please note: You cannot be a camper at your week of camp DURING the commitment block you select, so make sure to apply for a block that doesn't have a conflict.


#### **PROJECT UPDATE**
